# Dress Code!

STL Logo MUST be visible

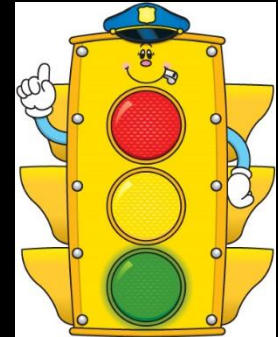


Ways to comply:

    - \*\*Administration will be involved if behavior continues or depending on severity\*\*

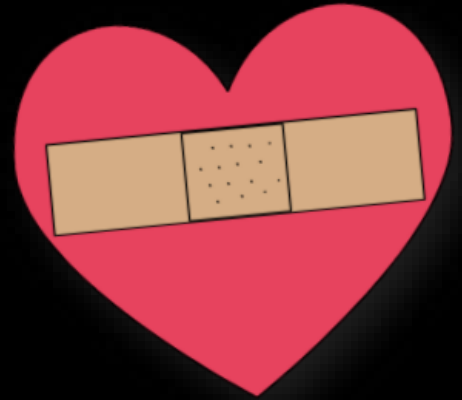


# Staying Organized!

  - Water bottle-no flavors
  - Don't bring toys & valuables



# School Work



## Daily Work

- Must be turned in on time
- Late work may be penalized
- Every night students should practice spelling words, read for 20 minutes, & study math facts

## Absent Work

- Work sent home after 2nd day out
- Have 1 day per day absent to return work

# Lunch Cards

- Make sure to monitor daily lunch choice (hot/cold)
- Sign up for account at Lunch Time Payment Portal if you haven't done so (see school website)
- Check balance frequently on website
- Add money to account online ONLY
- Missing lunch/library card \$10

- Nothing messy, sticky, greasy + easy to open
- Let teacher know of allergies

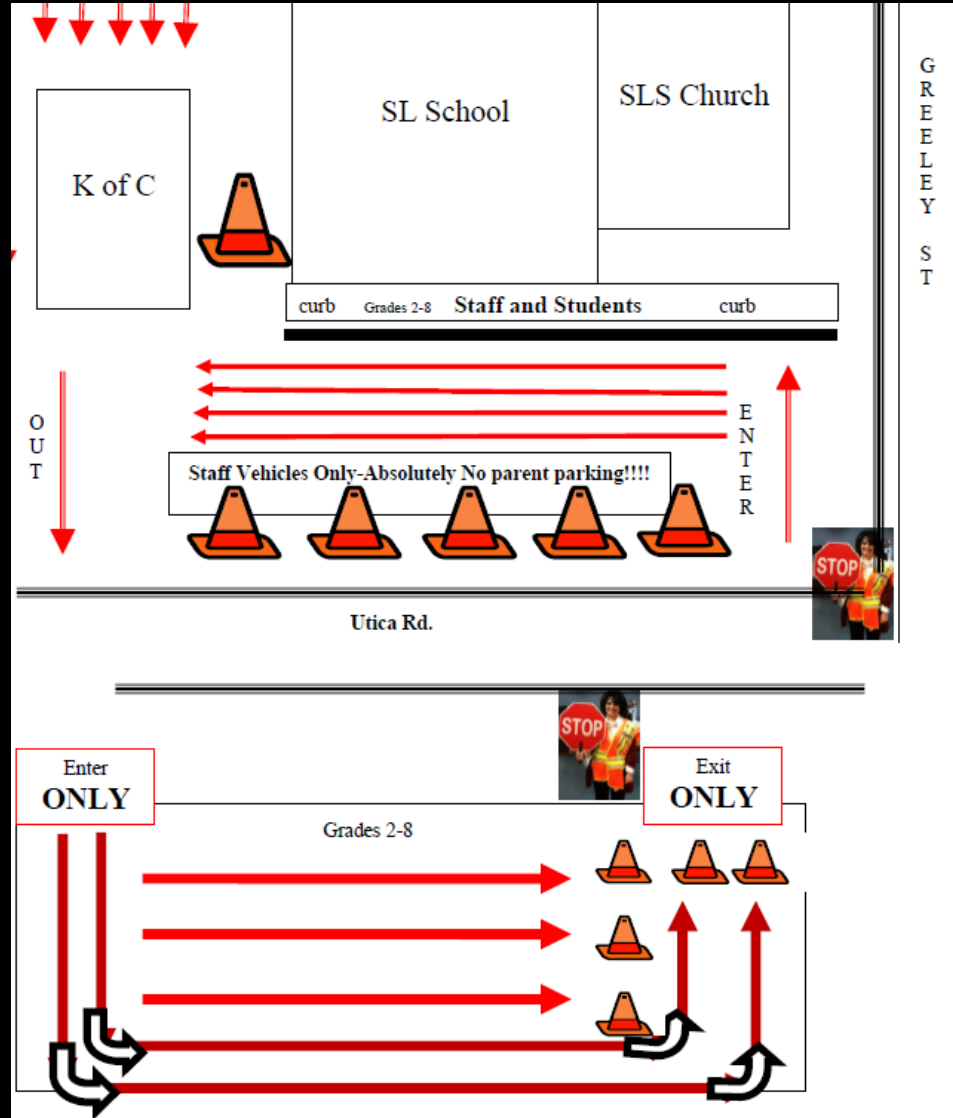
